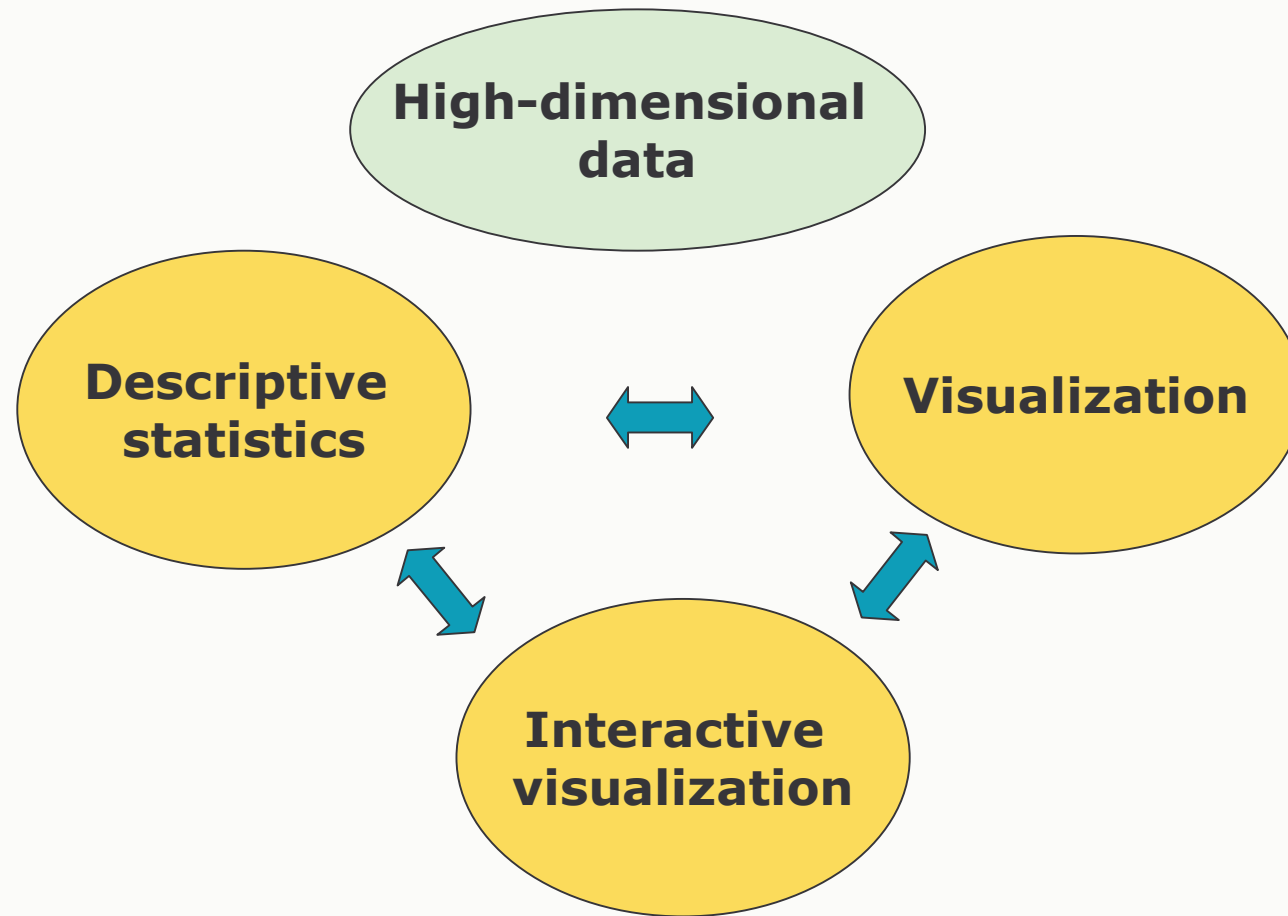


Statistics may broadly be defined as the theory and methods of extracting information from observational data and **model inputs and outputs** for solving real-world problems
